No-Cost Home Weatherization Available for Qualified Households in St. Johns and Clay Counties



The non-profit St. Johns Housing Partnership (SJHP) Weatherization Assistance Program provides no cost energy-efficiency improvements to qualified homeowners in St. Johns and Clay Counties.

What is Weatherization?

A comprehensive set of measures performed by SJHP to improve the energy efficiency of a home.

The repairs focus on building performance that reduces energy consumption and improves indoor air quality.

Three Good Reasons to Weatherize

Health: Documented studies have shown some improvement in occupant health or indoor environmental conditions. Some studies also observed reductions in asthma or respiratory related emergency department or hospital visits.

Energy Savings: Weatherization can lead to substantial reductions in energy consumption. A home remains warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer, reducing the need for excessive heating and cooling.

Lower Utility Bills: Reduced energy consumption directly translates into lower utility bills. Over time, the cost savings can be substantial, making weatherization a wise and cost-effective investment.

Not taking advantage of the no-cost SJHP Weatherization Assistance Program is a missed opportunity for low-income residents, who spend more of their income on energy and whose health is more likely to be affected by asthma, cold, and heat.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: To qualify for the Weatherization Assistance Program, the total household income may not be more than 200 percent of the national poverty level. <u>SJHP has more information</u>. Preference is given to owner-occupied homes, elderly (60 years-plus) or physically disabled residents, families with children under 12 and households with a high energy burden (repeated high utility bills).
